- ▶ Are you Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi, Sri Lankan, Nepali, or Bhutanese?
- ▶ Do you work as an employee, manager, or owner in a retail business, such as a store or gas station?
- ▶ Is the business in the city of Chicago—on the South side, West side, or Devon Avenue area?
- ▶ Are you above the age of 18?
